

NFPA 1001 – Fire Fighter I

Aim:

The aim of the NFPA 1001 Firefighter Level 1 course is to develop the student's knowledge, skills and understanding so that the student may operate safely and effectively as a professional fire fighter and meet the standards of NFPA 1001 level 1.

Course Overview:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will be able to demonstrate knowledge, skills and understanding of the NFPA Standard 1001, Chapter 5 - Professional Firefighter Qualifications. This course builds the core competencies required for a First Responder at the operations level and also builds several mission specific competencies. One such specific competency is Product Control in accordance with the NFPA 1072 standard for the Competence for Responders in dealing with Hazardous Materials and/or Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD). The following subjects are covered in detail:

- Self-Contained Breathing apparatus and PPE.
- General vehicle safety.
- Communications.
- Identification and use of Fire Service equipment;
- Firefighting media and their application.
- Fireman ship skills.
- Building entry and egress methods.
- Hazardous materials.
- Salvage operations.
- Post incident considerations and report writing.

This course is designed for:

Personnel with no previous experience of firefighting who wish to become an IFSAC/NFPA qualified, integral member of a professional fire and rescue team.

Entry Criteria:

There are no pre-requisite qualifications for this course.

Presentation and delivery:

Theoretical and practical.

Languages:

This course can be provided in the English or the Arabic language or in the English language with Arabic support.

Health and Safety on the Course:

Due to the physical nature and demands of this course, members must be sufficiently fit to undertake strenuous, physical activities. Course members must attend with suitable and sufficient Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) that is appropriate for the risks involved in fire and rescue operations. Alternatively, the college can provide PPE for course members.

Course staff and facilities:

Our professional instructors have the required technical knowledge and relevant operational managerial experience.

Number of candidates:

Minimum - 6

Maximum – 15

Assessment and Examinations:

Students will be continually assessed throughout the course. We use a range of assessment techniques including a written test, computer based multiple choice test, oral questioning and a practical skills demonstration.

Certification and Awarding Body:

Upon successful completion of this course, candidates will receive the International College of Engineering and Management course certificate, which is accredited by the International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 1001 for Fire Fighter I.

Venue:

Duration:

20 days over 4 weeks, from Sunday to Thursday. Daily timings are from 08:00 to 15:30.
